FIELD TOUR— Salmon River Hatchery Riparian Restoration Project

Tour Summary: The Salmon River Hatchery project consists of 4 project areas on Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) and Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) lands totaling approximately 9 acres. The project consists of site preparation, noxious weed control, native tree and shrub planting, and livestock exclusion fencing to reduce erosion and nutrient inputs to surface waters of the Salmon River. Funding for the project comes from the US Forest Service Title II program and the Oregon Wildlife Fund. *Water Action Plan Actions Addressed: 44, 46, 47, 50*
