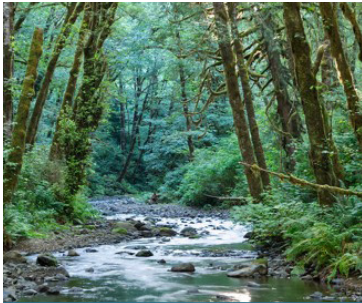


Why Participate in the Mid-Coast Water Planning Partnership?
